


SYNOPSIS

- Written by Stephen Schwarz and originally directed and choreographed by Bob Fosse.




VISION

VISION

- Minimal set using only white blocks that can be projection mapped onto.
- The band housed on two levels at the back of the theatre leaving the stage open for movement.





VISION

- The players themselves will be uniform and present throughout the whole show.
- Monochrome makeup and costume so that props and projections add colour and context.
- Vaudevillian aesthetic with a modern twist.
